Dates and times for fishing:

Competition starts: 02/05/2017 at 12:01am

Competition ends: 31/05/2017 at 12:00am

Where can you fish?

All fish are to be caught in Victorian waters. The Murray River for this purpose is considered Victorian waters.

Fish will not be accepted if caught in private waterways ie. dams or private waters.

Eligible fish and scoring system:

Fish species that can be entered: Estuary Perch, Murray Cod, Rainbow/ Brown Trout, Chinook Salmon, Redfin and Yellow Belly.

Estuary Perch scores 5 points or 8 points for 30cm and over.

Murray Cod scores 7 points or 10 points for 50cm and over.

Rainbow/ Brown Trout scores 3 points or 8 points for 45cm and over.

Chinook Salmon scores 3 points or 8 points for 45cm and over.

Redfin scores 1 point or 5 points for 35cm and over.

Yellow Belly scores 3 points or 6 points for 35cm and over.

All fish are to be photographed on club brag mat with membership card clearly visible. Photos are to be entered via the weighmaster and sent via email or text within the time frame of the duration of the competition (dates and times shown above).

The length of the fish will be determined by the weighmaster to the best of his/her ability from the photo submitted.

If the weighmaster cannot determine the length from the photo then that fish will not be accepted. The member will be alerted by the weighmaster as soon as practically possible.

The winner will be the member with the most points.

The Prizes:

The winner will be awarded with a \$100 gift voucher for Compleat Angler in Rosebud.

There will be a mystery prizes for one other entry.
