

Squid Competition Rules

The Competition

- Entry to the competition is open to all SPAC members
- Starts Saturday the 27th June at 12.01am and finishes 28th at 12.00pm
- All squid must be caught in Victorian waters.
- Overall Longest Bag (3 Squid) will be awarded a \$25 gift card for Compleat Angler

Measuring of Squid

- The competition uses a digital photographic measurement technique. Squid will not be weighed for competition purposes.
- The photo of an entry squid, on commercially available brag mat and member card must be clearly visible.
- The brag mat scale must be clearly readable.
- The photo must show the hood length of squid with tip clearly against brag mat stop end.
- The squid length measured is the hood length.
- The Weighmaster determines the length of the hood by photo enlargement for accuracy accurate to the half cm and records the entries in the competition record book.
- The Weighmaster determines the squid entered into the Overall Longest Bag categories taking the 3 longest squid of each competitor and adding their lengths.
- The Weighmaster's decision is final.

Communication

- Photo is to be sent to or taken by the Weighmaster text or email
- Weighmaster will acknowledge receipt of photo by return text or email or if physically presented to the Weighmaster by printed competition entry record.
- If the Weighmaster determines the photo is not clear or is not eligible for entry then a return text, email or verbal communication will occur requesting a valid photographic entry.
- The Weighmaster will inform the competitor of the entry by text message, email or printed competition entry record.
- Weighmaster will copy the photo entry and recorded length to the Club Secretary and the Web Site Manager and publications officer.



Prizes

- An overall prize will be awarded for
 - Longest Bag of 3 Squid.
 A \$25 gift card from comepleat angler
- Each minor weekend competition will have a prize awarded for
 - o Longest Bag of 3 Squid.
 - o Longest Land Bag of 3 Squid.
- A competitor can only win one of award categories for overall competition.
- A competitor can only win one of award categories for each weekend minor competition.
- In the event of a tie for any category(other than Mystery), two prizes will be awarded ie equal first prize.
- In the event of a tie for a Mystery length:
 - The tying Mystery competitors will be subject to a random draw to determine the winner.
